# STUDENT SUPPORT

### **DELIVERY METHOD**

FNTI features an **Intensive Professional Delivery Mode**. Class sessions usually take place over one week (5 days) every four to six weeks, during the academic year. This allows those with work, family, and other obligations to balance all of their commitments. It also allows employers to build capacity at work by granting students time away, while continuing on the job.
